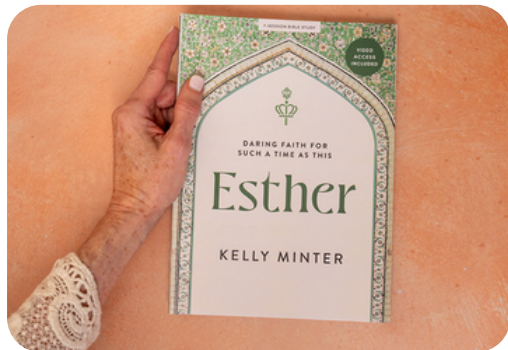

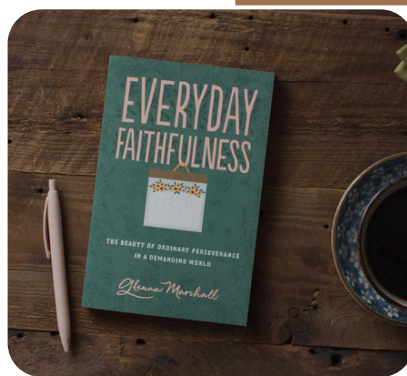
## Heart to Table Strawberry Mousse

- 8oz cream cheese or coconut cream
- 4oz yogurt
- 1 cup powdered sugar or alternative
- 5 medium sized strawberries
- ¼ tsp vanilla bean paste (optional)

1. **Let cream cheese come to room temp**
2. **Remove stems from strawberries and blend or mash until pureed**
3. **Add all ingredients to a food processor, blender, or hand mixer, and blend until completely smooth**
4. **Transfer to serving dishes and refrigerate**
5. **Enjoy once thickened!**
