**Comments/Questions received on 2/15/2026:**

**Comments/Questions received on 2/26/2026:**

**Q1. Our SGA website is where I get information on our church. However this important subject of expansion is not in the website. Wish all information on expansion can be accessible on SGA website.**

A1. If you came to this Q&A section, you have received all the information on this expansion.

**Q2. Fortunately i got a copy of the drawings and found that there are not too many rooms more than existing ones. I can only find 4 new Rooms 1,2,3 and 4 are added at the north side of the second floor presumably for staffs. So is this 4 more rooms will be enough for future increase in congregation sizes.**

A2. We are glad you have got hold of a copy of the drawing. What we need is to have more spaces, please refer to the PPTs #8&9 and 10.

According to our space programming, there will be one office on the second level for children ministry.

**Q3. On the same drawings, there large rooms marked CR, presumably it means Conference Rooms. Are they meant for providing meeting/activities rooms with moveable partitions?**

A3. CR meant Classroom not conference room. There is solid walls separating each classroom for sound reduction.

**Q4. Is second floor considered in the new addition?**

A4. The new addition consists of a gym, and an Education Wing with two levels of classrooms, spaces for larger groups.

**Q5. Gym/chapel is provided at the NE of the building. Is it practical to have this dual purpose space in a church. We are adding space for worship and for its related activities. I do not see gym is a related activity. That is why we should not include restaurants, sleeping quarters etc in the expansion for this reason.**

A5. Gym provides activities and promotes a healthy lifestyle.
