## Joint Heirs with Jesus Romans 8:16-17(LSB)

<sup>16</sup>The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, <sup>17</sup>and if children, also heirs, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

    1. God's Spirit provides victory over our flesh through indwelling (v. 9).
    2. God's Spirit provides victory over our flesh through regeneration (v. 10).
    3. God's Spirit provides victory over our flesh through resurrection (v. 10-11).
  - K. We have no obligation to follow the works of the flesh through living by God's Spirit ("so then..." v. 12-17).
    1. For God's Spirit enables the killing of the works of the flesh (vv. 12-13).
      - a. Destination 1- Flesh life = spiritual death (v. 12).
      - b. Destination 2 – and flesh death = Eternal spiritual life (v. 13).
    2. For God's Spirit leads us (v. 14).
  - L. We have an adoption into a heavenly family (vv. 15-17).
