Text: **Isaiah 52:13-53:12 and/or 1Peter 2:19-25**

Key ideas from the sermon:

1. Jesus' death has transformed death.
2. For those who belong to Jesus death has lost its sting. It is now as if we fall asleep.
3. For this in Jesus there is no fear in death - we know who we belong to and where we are going.
4. Jesus has made death a safe place for believers because we will be in the presence of the Lord.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Isaiah 52:13-53:12 and/or 1Peter 2:19-25]

1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:



Light bulb: This should be something that 'shine' from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.
