Sermon: The Supreme Good.

Scriptures: Psalm 73.



Even when life feels unfair or confusing, the greatest blessing is not wealth or success, but being **close to God and experiencing his love, that guides us and holds us securely forever.**

Scripture Questions:

1. What is your answer to Clive's grandchildren's question, "does God do miracles today"? if so, give examples. Can you say "I see a God who.....? If miracles are not for today, why do you say that?"
2. Psalm 73:1-16, is written by Asaph. The psalm wrestles with a deep question: Why do the wicked seem to prosper while the faithful struggle? What is your answer to that question?
3. Verse 23. What does this verse reveal about God's faithfulness even when we struggle spiritually? What might it mean that God "holds" our right hand? Can you recall a time when you sensed God guiding or supporting you?
4. Verse 24. What are the two promises found here? How does the promise of "glory" change the way we face our present difficulties?
5. Verse 25. What would it look like in daily life to love and truly desire God above everything else?
6. Verse 26, What does it mean for God to be the "strength of our heart"?
7. Verse 27. What warning is given to those who live far from God?
8. Verse 28. What is the greatest good in life? What does it mean to make God your refuge?
How can sharing God's works encourage others in their faith?

Personal Questions:

- Does this answer to question 2, satisfy you? The temporary prosperity of the wicked is nothing compared to the lasting rewards in heaven of the chosen in Christ. Romans 8:18-25.
- Why should you live a holy life and trust God for your future?
- How can you intentionally stay close to God in everyday life?

Prayer:

Thank You for the truth we see in Psalm 73. When we look at the world and feel disheartened, remind us that You are always with us. Thank You for holding our hand, guiding us with Your Love, and promising us a future with You. Help us to love You above everything else in heaven and on earth. When our strength fails and our hearts grow weak, be the strength of our hearts. Draw us closer to You each day and teach us to make You our refuge. In Jesus' name, Amen.
