## Devotional Reflection

In the parable of the talents, Jesus praises the servant who faithfully stewarded what had been entrusted to him. The words, "Well done, good and faithful servant," highlight the value God places on faithfulness.

This parable reminds us that God is not only interested in results. He cares deeply about how we steward what He has placed in our lives. Faithfulness is not measured by comparison to others, but by our willingness to honor God with what is already in our hands.

Sometimes we may feel that our role or influence is small. Yet God sees the heart behind our actions. What seems insignificant to us may be deeply meaningful to Him, because it reflects a life that is aligned with His purposes.

Faithfulness with what we have today prepares us for the responsibilities of tomorrow. As we consistently honor God in small areas, He develops our character and strengthens our capacity to carry more.

Over time, faithful stewardship leads to greater opportunities to serve and grow. God entrusts more to those who demonstrate that they can be trusted with what they already have.
