We are deeply grateful to the Lord, as we constantly feel your prayers and support.

Diego suffered from kidney stones that took him to the hospital and, after intense pain, to surgery. Now he is better, although he is waiting for a second intervention.

We are in the process of getting a replacement for our car; we sincerely thank those who have given us their support. If you can contribute, as we still need to raise more funds, we would greatly appreciate it.

The work is progressing very well, thanks to the Lord. We are taking the first steps for the next church plantation: El Redil de Guarne. Guarne is a town with more than 100,000 inhabitants where a Christian church of sound doctrine is required. Please pray for the planter team (Deiby, John, Felipe and César), who along with their respective families are motivated and being trained for this new church.

Our churches El Redil (now there are 17 of us!), are growing in their missionary sense. After several years of service to impoverished communities in different parts of the country and to indigenous communities in the Amazon rainforest, we are now dreaming of sending a couple to North Africa (Morocco) specifically. There are many opportunities that God has put before us. Thanks to the Lord, the El Redil churches are forming congregations that generate many leaders for the work. Pray for our missionary growth.

Most El Redil churches do not have their own place. In most cases, renting a place for our churches represents their greatest financial challenge. Currently, three of our congregations are in the process of acquiring a property to worship and develop their ministry. Please pray to the Lord for this.

Our family is well and happy. Emiliano, our oldest grandson, is already on his way to college. God bless you, thank you very much for always being there for us.
