

New Beginnings.

Dear Friends,

Spring is just around the corner!! With the changing season comes a new beginning.

Each of us experiences new beginnings in our lives: a new relationship, the birth of a child, a new job or adjusting to retirement. Whatever they may look like, new beginnings can be challenging, freeing, and exciting.

God is about new beginnings. God meets us in each of them. Each book of Scripture features a new beginning. The book of Genesis begins with the words " **In the beginning, God...**" In Chapter 12, Abraham was uprooted from Ur (now Iraq) to be grafted into the Hebrew people. Moses, at the age of 80 began to lead the people of Israel. In Isaiah, God encourages the people that He " **is making all things new**" (Isaiah 43:9). In fact, each Old Testament prophet experienced the weight of the mantle of their responsibility, as God called them into His service. In the New Testament, Jesus called ordinary people to begin, what would be a lifetime of learning as they followed Him and subsequently invited others to do the same.

The theme of Healing is yet another example of a new beginning. John Chapter 5 features Jesus' healing of a man who had been stumped for 38. Daily this man settled at his usual place beside a special pool - alongside all the other sick and afflicted people. Each person hoped to win the race into the pool to get healed. The crippled man never won that race...so he waited.

Jesus meets this man and asks the man a very interesting question: " **Do you want to be healed?**" (John 5:6) When we dig a little bit, we find that Jesus' question may not have been so odd. The man's healing would have serious implications - perhaps even brining chaos. Over the 38 years, he had developed a routine and coping strategies -relying on the community to help him.

This is what Jesus was asking: "Are you ready to lead a very different life?" or: "Are you ready to "walk" into a new dependence on God and not as much on others?" or "Are you ready for a new beginning?"

The man was willing to take the risk. At Jesus command, the man rose to stand on his newly strengthened legs and feet. John writes: " **at once, the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked.**" (John 6:9) At that point, the man began a new life.

Each healing in bible times and beyond, is a picture of the life that was meant to be experienced by all humankind. Jesus' question to this man can be applied to each of us. Do you want to be healed? Are you ready to walk into a deeper relationship with Jesus? Are you willing to begin a new way of faith and response to the world? Are you willing to allow Jesus to heal you of a crippled way of seeing the world?

Jesus is calling you and I walk in greater reliance on Him and to walk in His power. I urge you to listen to Him.
