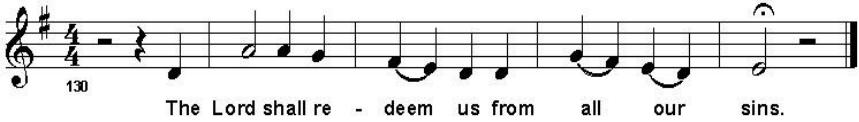

Lent 5 – Veiling of the Crosses

Every year on the 5th Sunday of Lent we veil the crosses in the church. This is because it marks a shift in the season of Lent where we go from focusing on repentance and faithful discipline, to walking with Christ through the last days of his life. Every cross in the church is a sign of the resurrection and, while we know that the resurrection is where the path ahead of us leads, it is important for us to remain with Christ through it all so that we know all that he endured to bring salvation and new life to us. Veiling the crosses is a visible way to remind us not to skip ahead to Easter, but to walk with Christ even as he heads back toward danger to raise his friend Lazarus from the dead, to enter Jerusalem, to sit at the last supper table, to head out to Gethsemane, to stumble into the room before Pontius Pilate, to stagger under the weight of the cross on the way to Golgotha, and finally to be placed in the tomb. When we walk all the way with Christ it makes our celebration all the richer and more joyful.
