


Fifth Sunday in Lent

Today's lessons:

- Ezekiel 37:1-14 In a vision the prophet Ezekiel sees God bring dry bones back to life: an image of the new life that God brings to his people Israel.
- Psalms 130 Nobody deserves God's help, but God will listen when we call for his help and he will help nevertheless.
- Romans 8:6-11 Paul outlines two opposing attitudes: that of the 'flesh' and that of the Spirit. Who lives driven by the 'flesh' will not live according to God's will; those who are driven by the Holy Spirit will lead God-pleasing lives. (The word 'flesh' here doesn't necessarily have anything to do with the body, but rather means 'self-centred life'.)
- John 11:1-45 When the sisters Mary and Martha send a message to Jesus that their brother Lazarus is sick, Jesus doesn't come right away, but only after Lazarus has died. Turns out, Jesus had planned that from the beginning; now he can call Lazarus out of the tomb and back to life, demonstrating that he is indeed the resurrection and the life, and the Lord.


Well, there are worse things to pursue, but more important is what you have in you (thinks Paul) – and if you shake the letters in the phrase above, you will find it:

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
Out of the Depths
