Jesus begins to comfort His disciples.

John 14:15

¹⁵ If you love me, you will obey what I command.

Real love expresses itself in obedience.

**Obedience is not the way we earn love from Christ;
It is the way we respond to love from Christ.**

John 14:16-17

¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever — ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth.”
