Stormwater Project: waiting for permits from L & I ...should get them within 3 weeks, then date to break ground and visit to congregation by Brandywine Engineers to show design plan. Church Roof & Bell:... NPS Grant going through and estimates gotten for Bell repair to be considered. Paint analysis estimate: is \$5400 and would be included in a future Church ceiling project (after current church roof project). Riverside Hall: Roof repair to start on Monday Feb 23...work is estimated to take 4 days. Kitchen Floor estimate received and donor will pay for floor and installation. Stained Glass window repair project being undertaken by HGDPC, who is waiting for estimate to replace wood sill. Brick Pathways: We have 3 estimates, all expensive. Property Committee Inventory of all buildings is in progress. Will report to Vestry in a few months. Gravestone Fragment Design: design was reviewed. Pew Plaques Delivered!: Plaques memorializing Paul Fejko and the Cox/Kock Family were delivered.	Rev. Chris will schedule a presentation by Brandywine to the congregation. Rev Chris will arrange to have members of Cox/Kock Family in attendance for installation of pew plaque if possible. Rev Chris will attempt to get a revised brick pathway estimate to ensure scope of work is same for all of them; HGDPC is looking for grant opportunities to fund the project.
Music Ministry: *Budget for Easter *Piano in Church?	Adam Haines suggested some new music for Easter. We have \$150 left over from Christmas Music budget. Octet at Christmas cost under \$1200. Adam Haines would like to donate his piano to the church. Discussion as to how it would fit, cost to move it, etc. was discussed and tabled until we have further information as to size and feasibility.	Motion made, seconded and approved to engage Octet for Easter at cost of up to \$1200.
