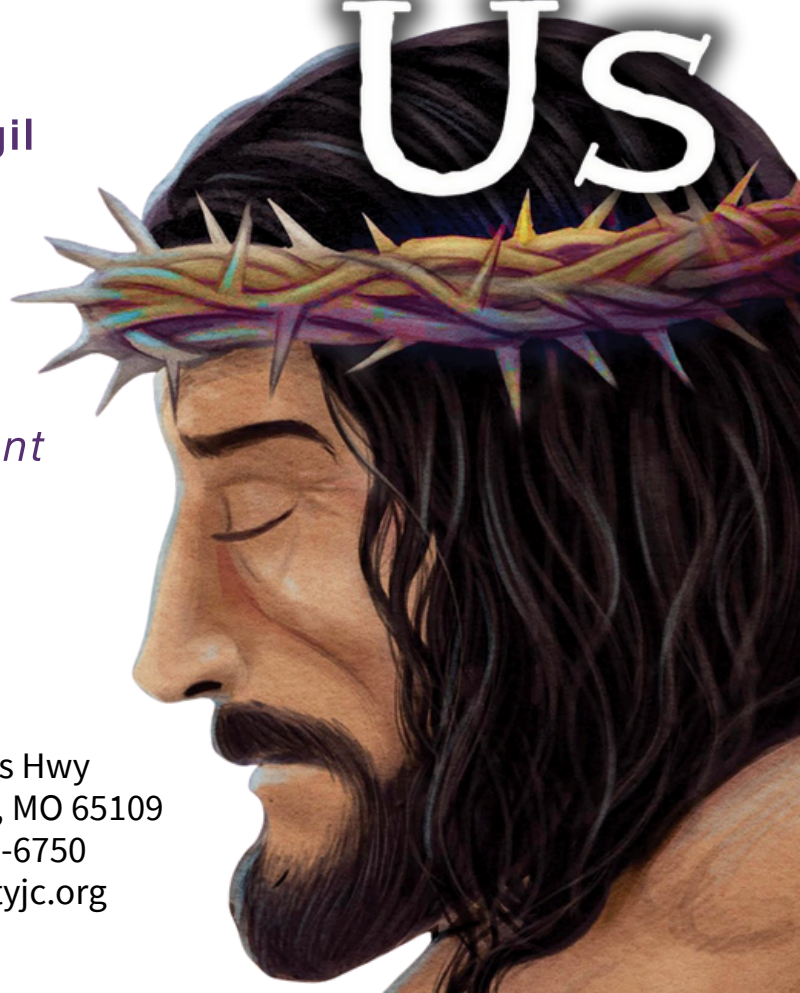

WELCOME

Come explore the culture of the Mediterranean through Music, Art, and Dance. Music, Art, and Dance Camp (MAD Camp) is a fine arts camp located in Jefferson City, MO. MAD Camp was founded in 2009 by Jennifer Boyd, Art Teacher, Jennifer Fults, Music Teacher, and Helen Haynes, Musikgarten Teacher.

MISSION

Music, Art, and Dance Camp's mission is to give children a fun and educational experience by enhancing their exposure to, and involvement in, fine arts. We explore history and culture through music, art, and dance.

OVERVIEW

MAD Camp offers a week-long camp in the summer, designed for children ages 4-12. The children are divided by age into small groups with teenage counselors. As a group they experience five classes each day:

- 2 Music classes
- 1 Dance class
- 2 Art classes

REGISTRATION AND FEES

The tuition is \$210 per camper plus a nonrefundable \$30 deposit per family. Registration and family deposit may be submitted early to secure your spot at camp. All fees (including deposit and tuition) are due no later than June 21st. Registrations received after June 21st will incur a \$20 late fee per camper. No refunds will be issued after June 21st. 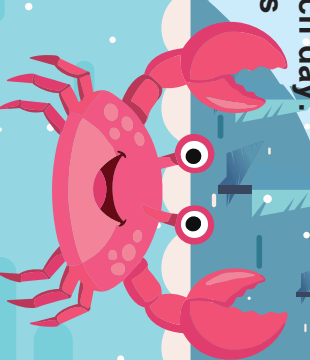
