**"The Pride Problem"**  
**Daniel 4:28-37**

**Introduction:** Reminder from last week's message where God gives Nebuchadnezzar a gracious, patient, compassionate warning. ---- "...those who walk in pride he is able to humble." Daniel 4:25 & 27

**Daniel 4:28-30** -- Nebuchadnezzar doesn't heed God's warning or attempts through Daniel to reason with him...

**Daniel 4:29-33** -- The consequences...

**PLACE FOR NOTES:**

**Jeremiah 18:1-6** -- Written in Nebuchadnezzar's day by another of God's prophets, God uses the example of a potter to describe how he shapes people to be what he has designed us to be...

**PLACE FOR NOTES:**

**Daniel 4:34-37** -- Nebuchadnezzar finally responds, turns his life to God, and repents of his pride. His repentance is exhibited in praise to God and in humility, and his desire that people know God and be in a relationship with the living God who loves them....
