Scripture- Luke 16:10

“Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much.”

Devotional Reflection

As you reflect on this week, remember that transformation is often built through small moments of faithfulness. The quiet choices you make each day contribute to the life God is forming within you.

It is easy to overlook these moments because they rarely feel significant in the moment. Yet each decision to trust God, respond with wisdom, and choose obedience is shaping your character in meaningful ways.

Faithfulness may not always feel dramatic, but it is deeply meaningful. Every act of obedience strengthens the foundation of your faith and builds a life that is steady and aligned with God’s purpose.

Over time, these small acts begin to produce visible change. What once required effort becomes more natural, and what once felt difficult becomes part of your daily rhythm. This is how transformation quietly takes root and grows.
