Beloved brothers and friends: Greetings! We would like to share some details of the ministry these past few months. We also have some prayer requests that we would like to share with you.

PANAMA In January, I was able to travel to Panama to visit the brothers and sisters there for a few weeks. It was a great joy to see how God has sustained His church. The brothers and sisters continue to strive in God's grace, and the various ministries continue to grow. Brother Cesar, along with a group of faithful brothers and sisters, is being used so that week after week the doors of the church may open and this work may continue to shine in Barranco Adentro. God willing, we will be traveling in June to support the medical tours and Vacation Bible Schools that the Gospel Preacher Association mission is organizing. Please pray for all the details, permits, investments, preparations, staff, and especially for the souls who will hear the gospel so that it may result in true disciples of Christ. Please also pray for the requests of our brother Cesar: for a wife for his life, for wisdom, and for a job (teacher).

AJUSCO Since last November, we have had the opportunity to visit and get to know a small mission in Ajusco. This place, located south of Mexico City, is known for having an inactive volcano and being the highest point in the city. The mission does not currently have a pastor there; some pastors travel there, but most tend to their own flocks. We have been blessed to be able to go, meet the brothers and sisters, and share the Word of God. (The mission has ten adults, including one young person, but no children or teenagers.) Please pray for the

possibility of continuing to support this mission more permanently. May God confirm His will in us and in them.

MINISTRY These past months we have been able to provide support in various ministries, as we explained previously. Both Abisag and I have participated in various roles, including sharing the Word, children's ministries, missions classes, men's and women's ministries, and personal evangelism. In this last area, we support the church every Thursday in a public park downtown, where they share the gospel with the lost. We aim to bring children and their parents by sharing educational materials, praying for them, and sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ. Please pray that God will continue to use us in every opportunity.

FAMILY By the grace of God, we are well. My father-in-law (Rodolfo) will soon begin radiation therapy for cancer. Please pray for him. On another note, Mexico continues to see rising crime rates and remains one of the most dangerous countries in the world. It's not easy to see everything happening around us without feeling overwhelmed, but our hope is in our great God. We trust that God's providence controls all things, and nothing escapes His power. We ask that you keep us in your prayers, and especially that God grant us peace and guidance as a family, as well as in the healthy upbringing of our son, Elián. We know that God is the one who sustains us, but without your support, we wouldn't know how to continue. Thank you so much for your faithful support, for believing in us, and for your love for God that motivates you to do and support missionary work in so many places.
