In his latest tests, his numbers have risen in a way that only God can make happen to the point that the doctor in charge has told us that if everything continues this way, he will probably be discharged from the hospital next week to continue his recovery at home. After so many days of uncertainty, of pain in our hearts seeing our little one in so much pain and suffering, where God has sustained us at every moment and I know will continue to sustain us, hearing this... well, I have no words to express what I feel in my heart. There's still a long road ahead. When Pablo returns home, he'll have at least three more months of isolation because his new bone marrow is like a baby's. He needs to start his vaccination schedule as if he'd never had any before, and his immune system must restart to protect him from infections, bacteria, and everything else we know is part of our daily lives as humans. But knowing that he's getting stronger and healing every day is something we thank the Lord for with all our hearts. Please continue praying for us. We're exhausted and sometimes physically weak. May the Lord help us keep going strictly following the protocols so that Pablo's process ends in the best possible way, and above all, for my son's full recovery so he can begin to live a life where he can thrive. These have been several years of great uncertainty and worry about Pablo's health, but we thank the Lord that He has watched over us, strengthened us, and lifted us up when we had no strength left to go on.
