24 March 2026

Preparation

Reflect back on your life and make a note of two things. Firstly, miracles that the Lord has done for you. Secondly, times where you obeyed and did what the Lord told you to do, and what happened as a result. Be ready to share your own testimony with your group.

Fellowship

Open in prayer.

Icebreaker: If you could ask God for one miracle, what would it be?

Worship

Discipleship

1. Reflect on the water pots being symbolic of the Old Covenant, and the wine symbolizing the New Covenant in Christ's blood. Discuss briefly, recapping on last week's sermon of Christ our righteousness. This is still the greatest miracle!
2. It is so important that we turn to the right person, to Jesus, when we need help. Why do we so often turn to him after trying all kinds of other avenues. Reflect on the words in the hymn "What a friend we have in Jesus" and discuss as a group, asking for examples of getting this right and getting this wrong.
3. Reflect on Mary's remarkable faith, and on the faith of the woman with the issue of blood. Is there something in your life that you need to press into in faith and then do whatever He tells you to do. Give him whatever is in your hand.
4. Talk about the fact that changing water into wine was a miracle of acceleration. What is the Lord saying to you about this?

Ministry

Break into groups of 3 and pray for one another. Stand in faith with each other for areas where you need Jesus's miracle help.

Evangelism

The term is closing this week. Ask LG members to think about a LG outreach that you could do together in Term 2.
