Dear Friends and Fellow Laborers,

I asked when he got saved and he was not sure so I proceeded to share the gospel with him and he realized that he was not saved. He bowed his head and asked the Lord to save him and then he got excited. I explained baptism to him, and he asked if he could get baptized that Sunday and we said sure. We went on to make our visits and when we came back to check out, he informed us that he had already told one his friends about his new life in Christ. Jacob brought his wife to church Sunday, and he got baptized.

We checked in with the duty and as we started down the hallway there was a Marine walking into the room we were going to. We knocked and Alston came to the door. He had a clear testimony about his salvation, and we asked if his friend Chris was saved, and was not sure. He took us to Chris' room and after sharing the gospel with him he trusted the Lord to save him, and they deployed the next day.

Caleb and Israel came to church and then attended the Bible study on Friday night at the Serviceman Center. They enjoyed a delicious meal and then participated in the Bible study about the importance of the church. I asked Israel after the Bible study if he was born again, he was not sure, so I sat down and explained the gospel to him, and he bowed his head and trusted the Lord to save him.

We are off to a great year and look forward to what the Lord will do through us as we look for times such as this. There were 11 saved and 3 baptized. To close out the letter the Lord gave us 8-10 inches of snow on the 31st. We will share more about that next month.

God has brought many blessings and led through some challenges over the last few months. It has been reassuring to watch God work in our lives and in the people's lives! There is still not clear direction for who God has for the position of pastor, and *we covet your prayers that God would clearly lead us to him and him to us.*

From the Heart of a Pastor - "A Call to Decision"



A Call to Decision

For more than four centuries the Children of Israel have served as slaves in a land where their forefathers had once sought shelter from a famine. The blessings that they had enjoyed because of their relationship with Joseph have long ceased as a new Pharaoh and a new dynasty has risen to power. Year after painful year they have labored and bled and died under the brutality of the whip. And day after day they had prayed for God to send them a Deliverer. When the time was right, God raised up Moses to be the leader of this great nation. After standing against Pharaoh, and having witnessed God perform miracle after miracle, Moses marched triumphantly out of Egypt with more than two million Israelites following him.

Leaving Egypt, the former slaves take with them flocks and herds and even great wealth from the Egyptians in the form of gold and silver. They have been rescued from bondage and freed from the hand of Pharaoh, not just once, but forever; as those who pursued them were engulfed in the Red Sea. Repeatedly, and in ways that defy human explanation, God has delivered His people. He now feeds them with manna and quail. When necessary, He gives them water from a rock or makes the bitter water sweet.

The people have now traveled beyond the banks of the Red Sea; to the place where God is giving instruction to Moses. Communing with Jehovah on the mountain, Moses receives the Tablets of the Law that are to govern the people of Israel, indeed the whole world. But as Moses has been on the mountain for many days the Children of Israel have begun to grow restless. In his absence, sin and iniquity has entered the camp. Approaching Aaron, Moses' brother, the people request that he make a god for them to worship; something they can bow down to and give thanks to for it having brought them out of Egypt. The entire nation is now in danger of being swept away from their faith in the God of their fathers by a flood of idolatry.

Into this scene walks the man of God. A Moses returns to the camp he hears the noise of the people. Joshua, who has been waiting for Moses, and who is away from the sinful activities, tells Moses that it is the sound of war. Yet Moses clearly recognizes that it is not the sound of war, but the sound of wickedness. The anger of Moses is now kindled against these horrible acts of idolatry that had engulfed the descendants of Jacob. It is as if they have quickly forgotten the darkness and the bondage from which God has liberated them. They appear to be committed to openly embrace idolatry. To this rebellious people Moses cries, *"Who is on the Lord's side?"*

As it was then, so it is now. There is a great need for those who will step out and unashamedly and without apology separate themselves to the side of the Lord. This is the same question that must be addressed today. I want to simply ask, *"Who is on the Lord's side?"* I am not asking, nor will I ask, if you are on this person's/politician's side or a supporter of this individual's agenda. What I ask is far more important. I am asking if you are on the Lord's side. The reason for my urgency is because it now seems rather difficult to tell whether a person is on the Lord's side or not.

We are living in an age of unprecedented actions and activities. We are watching the foundations of faith, family, and freedom be destroyed before our very eyes. We are in the midst of an unbelievable period of trials and tests, of unrest and uncivilized behavior. We are witnessing the masses be swayed by those who promise peace while they deliver destruction. If ever there was a time to be sure on whose side we are standing, it is now! If ever it was imperative for Godly men and women, boys and girls, to stand up and be counted for the cause of righteousness it is today!

This is why we need Revival. This is why we need another "Great Awakening" in America. This is why we need for pastors in the pulpit to cry aloud and spare not. And this is why we need people in the pew to *"Choose you this day whom ye will serve."*
