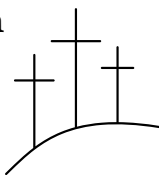

Mike was able to regularly visit two new church plants with Marton, one of the elders of Oroszlany Baptist. This above is the first official service in a city called Gyor. We praise God for the church (OBC) starting another church-plant.

“In order for us to transition well, we were recommended to focus on language learning during the first year. So our weeks and days have been adjusted to Paola’s language class in mind. Mike has been involved with meeting with the leaders of Oroszlany Baptist once a month. The task set for him was to be at each meeting of the church. He was able to do visitations with members of the church and have them over at our home as well.

By now, a more consistent schedule involves being at the church daily for some office hours of study and prayer. Preparing for Truth and Grace Publishing House (TMAI Global publishing has been great help). Organize evangelism outreach for the church. Preparing tracts and contacting printing companies for Gospel signs. Prepare for discipleship meetings, studying for different men’s studies and clean the church. Mike was able to reach out to some of our neighbors and people in the street as well.”

# Ministry Opportunity.

## Love Packages

**Founder: Steven J Schmidt**

“It was the summer of 1975: God spoke to me as clearly as could be. That summer, God showed me the abundance of Christian literature that I had at my disposal and the tremendous lack of literature in third world nations. Not realizing that everyone was as wasteful as I, I began to send my excess literature overseas. That first year my wife and I shipped sixty boxes of literature to missionaries in four countries. Soon the word spread about what we were doing. Friends started bringing their excess literature to us for shipment overseas. We never realized or imagined that from that small seed God would build an ever increasing world outreach.

Not long after that, we began to receive literature in the mail; slowly at first, then from all over the United States. That second year we shipped 3.5 tons. The third year: 7 tons. The fourth: 11, then 21, then 25, 27, 31, 51, 83, 100, 180, 250, and 600.

### **The Impact of Donated Bibles Today**

We continue to send Christian literature to missionaries and Christian workers around the world. Statistics tell us that every piece of literature will be read by an average of 20 people. Each container has at least 1 million pieces, so the potential is to reach 20 million every time we send a container.

We are thrilled that since the beginning of Love Packages in 1975, we have been able to send over 15,000 tons of literature.

We have seen thousands of people saved, healed, and delivered as a result of this mission. Pastors and Sunday school teachers have, for the first time, materials to study and teach from.

Love Packages currently sends 20-foot ocean going containers to port cities around the world. These locations act as distribution points and have the capability to distribute these materials to thousands of churches overseas.

Everywhere we have gone in America, we have found people with old or extra bibles or other Christian literature that they didn't know what to do with it. If you are one of these people, Love Packages is here to help you put that literature in the hands of people who are hungry for the Word of God.”
