## Palm Sunday

This Palm Sunday represents the culmination of the Lenten journey. This is a day in which we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and marks the last few days prior to the crucifixion. But, what a spectacle the first "Palm Sunday" must have been. The streets were lined with people who, with great anticipation and desperation, were looking to greet their Saviour with shouts of "Hosanna!" (meaning- "save now") Jesus seemed to be the object of their affection. The people believed that Jesus would bring political liberation and new life...according to their own imagination.

The people had *their* idea of what "Messiah" should look like. Jesus had another. Their "vehicle of choice" to deliver the king, would have been a white horse -The symbol of war and victory. Jesus, rode into town on a donkey - The symbol of peace... I am sure that the people hoped that Jesus' entry into Jerusalem would bring an overthrow to the existing structure and secure a stable system that was free. But, in a stunning paradox the triumph of Christ took place outside the city on a hill, in a place reserved for outcasts and sinners, on a cross.

It is paradoxical that the mournful, desperate cry of "hosanna" has become a song of praise. In Chapter 11 of the Revelation to John, you can hear the echo of the Hosanna in the company of angels praising God. The angel cries out and says, "The Kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord...and he will reign for ever and ever."

Friends, for such a time as this, though we find ourselves in desperate times, as God's people, we are NOT people without hope. We live in the hope that Jesus gives us strength to face each day and He is our focus for the future. The Lord IS coming soon. So, on this Palm Sunday, as we reflect on our relationship with Jesus, we must ask him to renew our hope as we await the day that we shall see Him face to face.
