Jesus said “A new command I give you: “...Love one another. In the same way I loved you, you love one another. This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples—when they see the love you have for each other.” John 13 verse 34

If you look at someone and they seem to love really well - they honour by taking action - they give up their own comfort - sacrificing so others can benefit - doing the tough things - often going against the flow - that's a good indication that Jesus is the focus of their lives because as they follow Jesus - they love and honour Him by loving and honouring others! 
