### OAK GROVE GOSPEL MEETING - APRIL 12 - 15

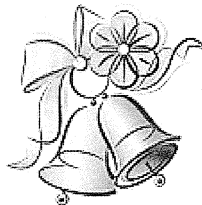

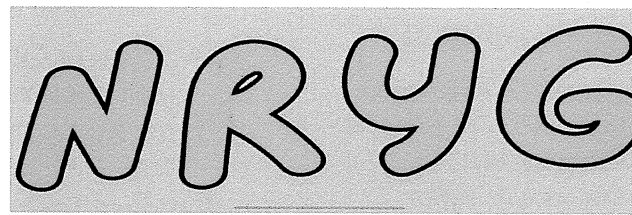
