
2025 In Review

Another year has come and gone and we can't help but stand in awe of God's continued faithfulness over the last year. We had another great year of ministry filled with smiles, hugs, learning, sweet hellos and hard goodbyes, growth, and lots of love. Eleven teams came to visit in 2025 and two interns served alongside us for 10 weeks each. We added new classes to our curriculum in the Children's Ministry, including STEAM and theatre class, and started new clubs for our youth to participate in. This year we enrolled 19 new children and bid farewell to 7 graduates who have completed our program.

Throughout 2025 we witnessed lots of growth, not only in our children and youth, but also in our facilities as we continue to grow and improve the spaces God has provided us to minister to our students. We continue to see progress and God's timing and provision as we move closer to breaking ground on the Career & Training Center. We are excited to see how God will continue to grow Nueva Esperanza in 2026!

Christmas at Nueva Esperanza

One of the things we do well at Nueva Esperanza is celebrations! This year was no exception! For the first time in about 5 years we were able to bring back our Christmas program and invited family members to attend. We held it on a Saturday, partnering with a local church who has started a church plant on our soccer field. Over 200 family members came to the service and the Christmas program that followed. They heard a great message about the real meaning of Christmas and watched the kids sing lots of beautiful Christmas songs that praised the Lord. It was a beautiful celebration!



Following the Christmas Program, we moved into end of year Christmas parties with our youth and children! For our youth, their party included fun games (this year there was exploding glitter balloons!), receiving their Christmas gifts, a program looking back at the year and honoring those with high achievements, and a special dinner.



During the kids Christmas party they also played fun games, painted Christmas shirts, had a special snack, and opened their Christmas gifts! There was lots of fun and laughter on their last day before break.



Graduations



The end of the year also brings the end of the school year in Honduras! We love to recognize our students graduating from various times of their studies. The three big graduations are Kindergarten (as they prepare to enter the public school systems in first grade), 6th grade, and of course, their 12th grade graduation! For our Kindergarten graduation, parents came to the ministry one morning to celebrate with their child. The kids put on a program with a couple songs, including a nativity scene! Our teachers shared with parents many of the things their children have learned in preschool and congratulated them on their role in raising their children.

During our youth Christmas party we took some time to recognize our 6th grade graduates. In Honduras, 6th grade is the last year of elementary school. In 7th grade students enter high school, where their schooling becomes more expensive and challenging. We are excited to continue growing with these students in the future!



Finally, we celebrated our 7 seniors: Sharon, Josue, Mayel, Karen, Mariel, Brian, and Merary! These students started at Nueva Esperanza between the years of 2010-2012 when they were 3-5 years old. We have loved watching these students grow over the last 15 years and are so proud of all that they have accomplished. They have overcome so much and we pray they will continue to follow the Lord in their future plans.


