Jesus Paid It All

Communication Column

Today is Palm Sunday. This is the day of the Triumphal Entry 2,000 years ago. Jesus comes into Jerusalem riding in on a donkey. There was a very large crowd who had been waiting on the Messiah. The crowd had spread clothes and branches on the road. Matthew 21:9 says “Then the crowds who went ahead of him and those who followed shouted:

**Hosanna to the Son of David!
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!
Hosanna in the highest heaven!”**

Hosanna means “save please or save us now”. This is what Jesus was coming to do. He was coming to save people from their sin. The time had come that the Messiah would do what had been prophesied so many years ago.

As we enter Holy Week, we think about the days after the Triumphal Entry. Jesus would be arrested, beaten, spit on, mocked, crown of thorns put on his head, He would carry His cross, and Simon of Cyrene would help him, nailed to the cross, a lot of suffering, and He would die and be buried. As we think about the details of the week there was a range of emotions during those few days.

As we think of what Jesus went through, there are a range of emotions that go through our mind. We are excited that He died on the cross for our sins, but sorrow also enters because our sin is nailed to the cross with an innocent man taking it for us. It can be overwhelming to think about, but grateful that Jesus was the substitute for us. He paid it all and we don’t deserve it.

As you think about Holy Week this week and what Jesus went through, there may be a range of emotions that go through your head. It’s okay to be excited for what Jesus did, but also to have sorrow. We can be thankful and grateful for the cross. We don’t make ourselves good, but Jesus does because of the cross.

We will be having a Good Friday Service this week at 6:30 p.m. in the Sanctuary. We will be taking communion. This is an opportunity to reflect on what Jesus did on the cross and repent of sin in our life. SUNDAY IS COMING!
