

## Showing 5 verses containing practice

### Luke 5:32-35 AMP

[32] I did not come to call the [self-proclaimed] righteous [who see no need to repent], but sinners to repentance [to change their old way of thinking, to turn from sin and to seek God and His righteousness].” [33] Then they said to Him, “The disciples of John [the Baptist] often **practice** fasting and offer prayers [of special petition], and so do the disciples of the Pharisees; but Yours eat and drink.” [34] Jesus said to them, “Can you make the wedding guests of the bridegroom fast while he is with them? [35] But days [for mourning] will come when the bridegroom is [forcefully] taken away from them. They will fast in those days.”

### Luke 6:25-29 AMP

[25] Woe to you who are well-fed (gorged, satiated) now, for you will be hungry. Woe to you who laugh now [enjoying a life of self-indulgence], for you will mourn and weep [and deeply long for God]. [26] Woe to you when all the people speak well of you and praise you, for their fathers used to treat the false prophets in the same way. [27] “But I say to you who hear [Me and pay attention to My words]: Love [that is, unselfishly seek the best or higher good for] your enemies, [make it a **practice** to] do good to those who hate you, [28] bless and show kindness to those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. [29] Whoever strikes you on the cheek, offer him the other one also [simply ignore insignificant insults or losses and do not bother to retaliate—maintain your dignity]. Whoever takes away your coat, do not withhold your shirt from him either.

### Luke 6:45-48 AMP

[45] The [intrinsically] good man produces what is good and honorable and moral out of the good treasure [stored] in his heart; and the [intrinsically] evil man produces what is wicked and depraved out of the evil [in his heart]; for his mouth speaks from the overflow of his heart. [46] “Why do you call Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not **practice** what I tell you? [47] Everyone who comes to Me and listens to My words and obeys them, I will show you whom he is like: [48] he is like a [far-sighted, practical, and sensible] man building a house, who dug deep and laid a foundation on the rock; and when a flood occurred, the torrent burst against that house and yet could not shake it, because it had been securely built and founded on the rock.

### Luke 6:48-49 AMP

[48] he is like a [far-sighted, practical, and sensible] man building a house, who dug deep and laid a foundation on the rock; and when a flood occurred, the torrent burst against that house and yet could not shake it, because it had been securely built and

founded on the rock. [49] But the one who has [merely] heard and has not **practiced** [what I say], is like a [foolish] man who built a house on the ground without any foundation, and the torrent burst against it; and it immediately collapsed, and the ruin of that house was great."

Luke 11:26-29 TLB

[26] Then it goes and gets seven other demons more evil than itself, and they all enter the man. And so the poor fellow is seven times worse off than he was before." [27] As he was speaking, a woman in the crowd called out, "God bless your mother-the womb from which you came, and the breasts that gave you suck!" [28] He replied, "Yes, but even more blessed are all who hear the Word of God and put it into **practice**." [29] As the crowd pressed in upon him, he preached them this sermon: "These are evil times, with evil people. They keep asking for some strange happening in the skies to prove I am the Messiah, but the only proof I will give them is a miracle like that of Jonah, whose experiences proved to the people of Nineveh that God had sent him. My similar experience will prove that God has sent me to these people.
