SERMON "THE CROSS: IT'S EITHER FOOLISH... OR IT'S EVERYTHING"

MEMORY VERSE

The word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (1 Corinthians 1:18)

For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." ²⁰Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? ²¹For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe. ²²For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, ²³but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, ²⁴but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. ²⁵For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. ²⁶For consider your calling, brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. ²⁷But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; ²⁸God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, ²⁹so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. ³⁰And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, (1 Corinthians 1:19-30)

1. THE CROSS _____ YOUR INSTINCTS.

We preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block... and folly... (v.23)

He had no form or majesty... no beauty that we should desire him. (Isaiah 53:2)

God chose what is foolish... weak... low... despised... (v.27-28)

So that no human being might boast in the presence of God. (v.29)

None is righteous, no, not one... (Romans 3:10)

He was pierced for our transgressions... crushed for our iniquities... (Isaiah 53:5)
