Dear pastor and praying friends,

Greetings with gratefulness to all our supporting churches and friends. We have much to be thankful for in all that the Lord has done for us since we arrived back to Colombia in February to start our religious visa process.

We recently moved to a city just outside of Medellin in order to work with another missionary to improve our language learning and experience within the culture. We will also continue with some conversational classes on a less formal basis to assist with fluency in the language and expanding our vocabulary for the ministry. Some of the ministries we will participate in include evangelism, Bible institute, Sunday school, VBS, choir, English teaching, and discipleship. Aaron will also have the privilege of preaching every Sunday evening.

We have been able to get semi-settled into the new house and are enjoying the cooler temperatures of the higher altitude.

It has been interesting trying to communicate more in Spanish in a public setting with purchases and contract signing. We are grateful for the American missionary here who has helped us in a great way to accomplish some of these new challenges.

Please continue to pray for these requests: for the salvation of many here and in the Amazon as we labor among them; for Kristia's knee to continue to heal and strengthen; for us as we expand our vocabulary and conversation of the Spanish language and become more involved in the ministry; and pray that the Lord will grant us favor and give us at least 2-3 years on this visa application (the application will be submitted and reviewed in April.)

We plan to take at least three missions trips to the Amazon Basin this summer, and we pray the Lord will use us mightily as we move into more permanent roles in the Amazon for Christ ministry this year. We will be there in April for a brief planning/survey trip for the upcoming connect trip to Brazil, Colombia and Peru.

We are thankful the Lord blessed with a new granddaughter after returning back to Colombia. Everyone is well and we praise the Lord for this new addition.

Thank each of you again for the support, prayers, and communication over the past several months. We are thankful and humbled by the opportunity to be an extension of your ministry here in South America.
