Please pray for God to give us courage in this unbelieving, skeptical age to boldly declare what Christ has done for us. We appreciate your continued prayers for God to build this group of believers and empower them to impact their area for Jesus. Every small step of faith taken by them is a great encouragement to me personally, and I believe God wants to use their lives and families in a powerful way.

As far as the high school outreach goes, we have settled on a system where we can have an "English club" at the school itself, minus the Bible teaching; and then use that connection to invite the kids who come to the club to a separate youth meeting in our home, which we can use to formally introduce them to Jesus and make disciples. That way the school isn't officially endorsing a religious meeting, but it can be a catalyst for reaching young people. We will try this out after Spring break, and I hope to have a good idea of how this could work before the summer break and our furlough in the States.

We still haven't had anyone join us for our special needs activity on Wednesdays at Andrew's elementary school. The staff at the school were really encouraging to us, though, and told us to keep trying. Please pray that God would give us a door into that community here in Nagykanizsa.
