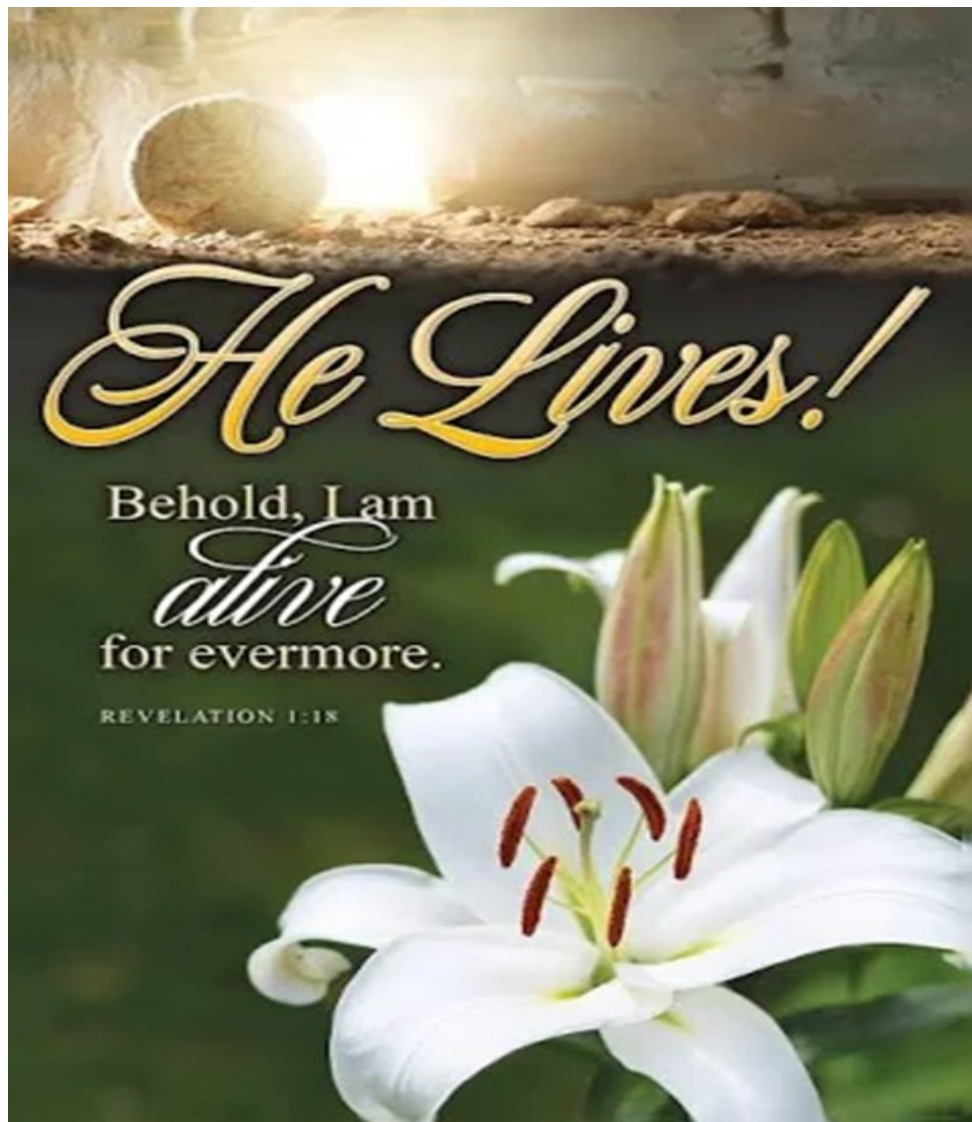
Remember?

## TEENS—NEXT SUNDAY EVENING!

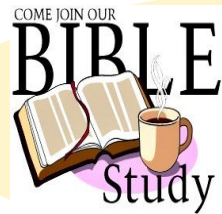
