Dear Brethren,

I received a phone call from Missionary Alex Araya tonight concerning the progress on his current project at the Coronado Camp. Construction is underway of the new gymnasium that has been designed for the camp. A budget of \$70,000 was established to complete the project. The First Baptist Church of Coronado has raised a good portion of what is needed, but they still lack some \$40,000 to finish the construction by August of this year. However, to attach the roof, an amount of \$6000 is needed by this Saturday to pay for the labor costs of a special crew hired to do the work. If that money is not provided, the labor crew will move on to another job. This would mean having to search for another work team to install the roof before the rain starts. The installation of the roof cannot be delayed due to the start of the rainy season (their winter), which normally sets in sometime in April. If the roof is not installed now, the work would be delayed for another 2 or 3 months. So, we are trusting that God would supply the needed \$6000 to pay the labor cost for installing the roof.

Here is the breakdown of what is needed to complete the overall \$40,000 project:

Flooring: \$22,000

Lighting and electrical system: \$3,000

Walls: \$5,000

Labor for the remaining roof installation: \$6,000

Stairs: \$4,000
