

Philippians 2:5-18 Prayer Guide

Prayer prompts follow CSB wording & the pattern of the Lord's prayer in Matthew 6:9-13
Remember the ABC's—Be Audible, Brief, & Clear

REVERENCE (“Your name be honored as holy”—Matthew 6:9)

- **Identify and celebrate God’s praiseworthy attributes.**
 - (ie, he sent his Son to save us! (vs. 5-9); his Spirit works in us (vs. 13); his word is life (vs. 16))
- PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 5-18)
 - Father, I give you glory because/for...
 - Jesus, your name is...

RESPONSE (“Your kingdom come, your will be done...”—Matthew 6:10-11a)

- **Identify areas of your life that need to be reoriented to God and his ways.**
- PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 5, 12, 14)
 - Father, I confess that my attitude is not like Christ’s when it comes to...
 - Father, help me have a Christ-like attitude when I/as I...
 - Father, help me _____ without grumbling and arguing...
 - Father, help me obey you as I...

REQUESTS (“Give us....and forgive us...”—Matthew 6:11b-12)

- **Ask the Spirit to guide your prayer over concerns, relationships, and resources**
- PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 13)
 - Father, help (me/person) both to will and to work according to your good purpose as I/he/she...
 - Father, help (me/person) know that you are working in me/him/her as I/he/she...
 - Father, please provide (me/person) with _____ as I/he/she seek(s) your good purpose in...

READINESS (“Do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us...”—Matthew 6:13)

- **Encouragement and strength for the spiritual battle**
- PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 15-18)
 - Father, protect (me/person) from this crooked and perverted generation as I/he/she...
 - Father, help (me/person) be blameless and pure as I/he/she...
 - Father, help us hold firm to the word of life as we...
- Group response after each prayer: “Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus.”
