## VICAR'S VOICE

### Courage When it Counts—St Alban

Friends, in the Creeds, we confess that we believe in the “Communion of Saints.” This includes those living and those who have gone on before us. I want to tell you about St Alban.

Alban was a significant figure in history. According to St Bede’s Ecclesiastical History of the English People, Alban was a pagan living at Verulamium (now St Alban’s), who converted to Christianity, and was executed by decapitation on a hill above his home town in the 3rd or fourth century. St Alban’s Abbey was later founded near this site.

What about his life? Alban was a Roman soldier. The story is that he provided shelter for a priest who was fleeing from persecution under Caesar Severus. When he hosted the priest, Alban observed his piety and faithful devotion to God in his daily prayers. Alban began to question the Priest about his faith. Soon, the priest baptized Alban.

Meanwhile, Severus got word of the Priest’s whereabouts. Caesar sent soldiers to capture the priest. Alban, seeing them coming in the distance, took the priest’s cloak and put it on himself. When the soldiers arrived, Alban stepped forward claiming his name to be “Amphibulus” - (the name of the Priest’s cloak). By taking this action, he was making a statement that he was the priest.

Alban was taken before the magistrate, who was furious at the deception and ordered that Alban be given the punishment due to the priest - if he had indeed become a Christian. Alban declared: "I worship and adore the true and living God who created all things." These words are still used in prayer at St Albans Abbey. St Alban was eventually sacrificed to the Roman gods and was condemned to death. He was taken out of the town across the River Ver to the top of the hill and martyred.

Friends, we notice in this story, several exchanges. An exchange of name: Alban to Amphibulus; an exchange of clothing: soldier’s to priest’s; and a spiritual exchange: pagan to believer.

Jesus, at the Cross offers an exchange of our sin for His righteousness. He wants you and I to take his cloak and give him ours as tattered as it is. I encourage you all, along with me to take Jesus' cloak upon you as we follow Him each day.
