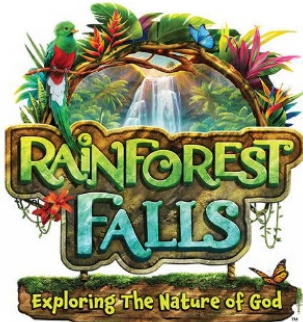


TRINITY LUTHERAN CHURCH VBS

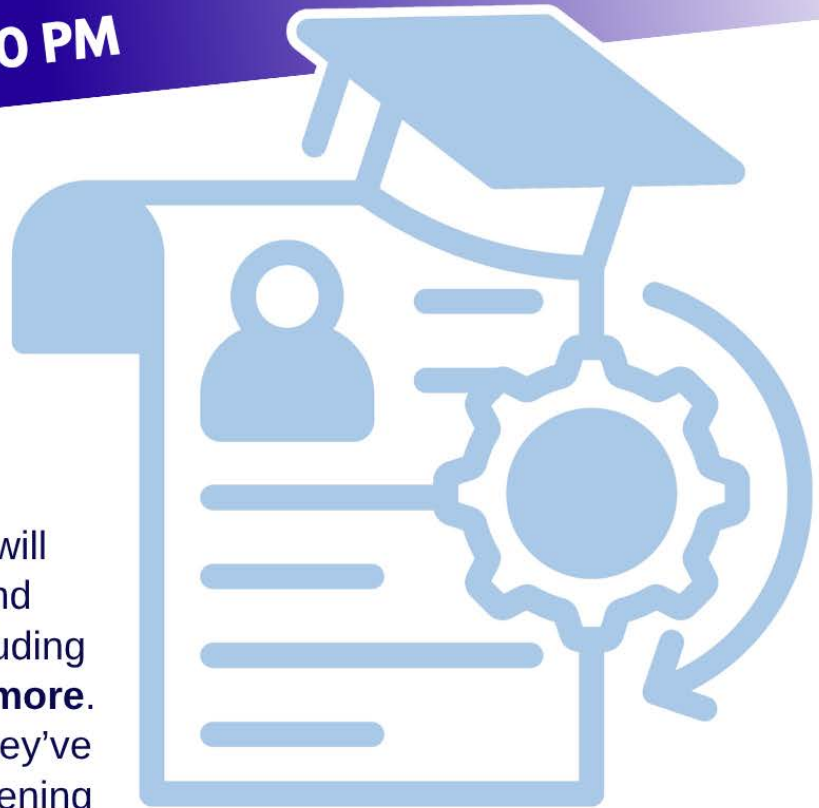
