BIBLE DONATION PROJECT - YOUR HELP NEEDED

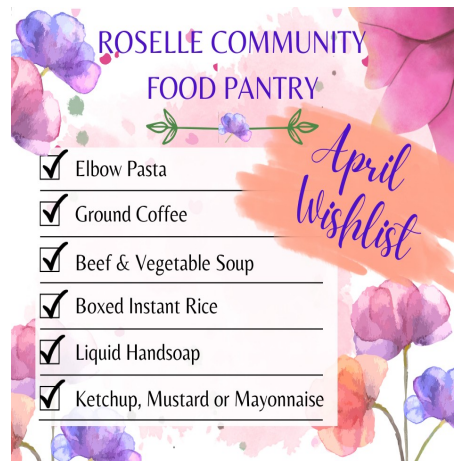
