John 4:4-30 | April 12, 2026

1. When have you recently experienced a “season” where you felt like God was clearly present—or felt distant?
2. What stands out to you about Jesus choosing to go through Samaria instead of around it?
3. How does the idea that “you may feel unseen, but you are never invisible to God” challenge or comfort you?
4. In what ways do we tend to bring “surface-level” prayers or issues to God instead of what’s really going on underneath?
5. The message compared this moment to a “check engine light.” What are some ways people ignore or avoid deeper issues in their lives spiritually or emotionally?
6. Why do you think the detail about the woman “leaving her water jar” is significant? What does that symbolize?
7. What are some “old jars” (old ways of thinking, coping, or living) people might need to leave behind today?
8. This week, where do you most need to remember that you are seen, known, and loved—and what would it look like to respond to Him in that area?
