



Frequently Asked Questions

1. What ages do you accept?

We offer a K3 program for children who are 2 and 3 years old by September 1, 2026.

2. My child is not old enough/too old to attend but I am still interested, what can I do?

We would love to hear from you! Please reach out to us by email or phone to let us know of your interest. The more we hear from families, the better we are able to plan for future classes and expand our program offerings. Sharing your interest helps us take the next steps toward meeting the needs of our community.

3. Does my child have to be potty trained?

No, children do not need to be potty trained upon enrollment. Potty training is addressed throughout the school year, and parents are expected to cooperate and encourage progress at home. If your child is not potty trained at the start of the K3 school year, it is strongly encouraged that they are potty trained prior to the end of K3. It is our goal to work alongside your family to potty train your little one.

4. What is your class size?

We maintain a maximum enrollment of 12 students per classroom, ensuring personalized attention and a safe environment.

5. What are your school hours?

- Regular Hours: Monday–Friday, 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM
- Early Drop-Off: 7:30 AM
- Pick-Up (for Preschool): 11:45 AM – 12:00 PM
- Extended Care (Optional): 12:00 PM – 3:00 PM

6. What if I need my child to stay later than 3:00 pm?

Extended care beyond 3:00 PM may be available on a case-by-case basis. We understand that families have varying schedules and work commitments, and we want to support



you as best we can. Please reach out to our director to discuss your specific needs, and we will work together to find a solution that best fits your family.

7. What is your tuition?

- Annual Tuition: \$5,000
- Payment Details: See our tuition schedule for installment options
- Afterschool/Extended Care: Separate fees

8. How do I apply?

- Complete the online application
- Submit the application fee
- Secure your spot with a deposit applied to tuition
- If the program is full before your application, your deposit will be refunded

9. What is your sick child policy?

Children must stay home if they:

- Have a fever (must be fever-free for 24 hours)
- Experience two or more episodes of diarrhea or vomiting
- Appear lethargic or unwell
- Other concerns at the discretion of the director or teacher
