

The Life and Letters of Paul

2 Corinthians 6

1. Starts the chapter by reminding them that it was God who sent him and not to take for granted the grace of salvation. Have you or are you now taking for granted the gift of Salvation.

2 Corinthians 6:1/ Matthew 28:19-Jesus offers the same partnership/ Hebrews 2:3-salvation taken for granted.

2. Do you live in a way where it would be hard to find fault in your testimony no matter the season you may be in?

2 Corinthians 6:3-4/ Matthew 5:48(AMP)- actively integrating godly values

3. What are some of the adversities you have encountered in your walk, Paul gives a list of his.

2 Corinthians 6:5/ Acts 14:5-6, 19-20/ Acts 16:19-24-dragged, stripped and beaten

4. Paul describes the spirit with which he faced suffering, attributing his strength to the presence of the Holy Spirit within us. How would you respond to these attacks?

2 Corinthians 6:6-7/ Matthew 5:38-42- Jesus speaks on revenge

5. Paul states that people may mistreat you, slander you, take from you and you may have season of lack, but your relationship with God should remain the same.

2 Corinthians 6:8-10/ Romans 8:35-39- what can separate us?

6. Paul speaking to the church with a plea to remember he was there at the beginning of their journey of faith; however, people have come in to disrupt this relationship. His plea is to remind them of the love he has for them, like his children.

**2 Corinthians 6:11-13/Galatians 1:6-7- Paul had to remember the church many times/
Revelation 2:4-you have left your first love**

7. When we made a decision to confess Jesus as our savior you were made righteous, set apart, from the darkness of your former life and those still running in those circles, it is not wise to go back to that team.

**2 Corinthians 6:14-15/ 1 Corinthians 15:33- who you know is how you roll/ John 1:5-9-
the two cannot coexist (in a society where we believe they can- ELE)**

8. God was very serious on holiness in his temple physically and that still holds true to the temple of now, that being you and me. Are we just as serious about our own temples?

2 Corinthians 6:16/2 Chronicles 29:5- Purify yourselves, and purify the Temple

9. In order for us to come close to God we must come out from the hinderances in our lives that are separating us from full access of him.

2 Corinthians 6:17-18/ James 4:8- Wash your hands, you sinners
