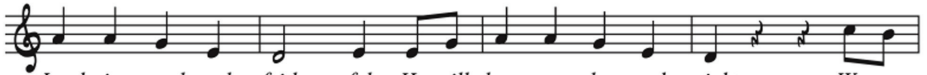
# Jesus Strong and Kind
