## SUNDAY REFLECTION

### This Is My Moment to Surrender

*April Series: Living The Resurrection Life*

*Week Focus: Live the Crucified Life*

#### Scripture – Galatians 2:20

“I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me.”

#### Devotional Reflection

Take a moment and reflect—not just on what you heard today, but on what God is asking of you right now. This week was not just about understanding the crucified life—it was about stepping into it. You have heard the call to surrender, to release control, and to allow Christ to live through you. Now the question becomes personal: what will you do with what you’ve received?

The truth is, you cannot fully experience the life God has for you while holding onto the life He is asking you to release. There are areas of your life—your thinking, your control, your patterns—that cannot go with you into what God is forming. Surrender is not optional for transformation—it is essential. What you release determines what God can develop within you.

This moment is not about perfection—it is about decision. Just like the altar call, this is your opportunity to respond. Whether you are choosing Christ for the first time or choosing to surrender more deeply, this is your moment. You do not have to wait for another day or another feeling. Transformation begins with a decision to let go and trust God fully.

Today, respond intentionally. Identify what God is asking you to surrender and release it to Him. This is not just reflection—this is activation. As you surrender, you create space for Christ to live through you. What you let go of today positions you for the life you have been praying for. This is your moment—don’t hold back.
