Sermon Series: Christ Above All

Sermon Title: "Give Jesus Honour Where Honour Is Due!"

Primary Text(s): Colossians 1:15-20

1. **Read Colossians 1:15-20**
2. Have you ever tried mixing two foods that didn't work together? What did you mix? What happened?
3. Paul originally wrote this passage as a corrective one. What was the Colossian Heresy and what were the false teachers promoting?
4. What titles or descriptions of Jesus stand out? What phrase feels the most significant to you personally?
5. What does it mean that Jesus is the image of the invisible God and the firstborn over all creation? How does this shape how we understand God?
6. The passage says that all things were created by Jesus and for Jesus. What does that imply about our lives? What areas of life are hardest to see as "for Jesus"?
7. How do you see God's creativity at work in yourself, in others, and in this world?
8. Verse 17 says: "In Him all things hold together." Where do you feel like things are falling apart in life right now? What does trust in God look like?

Leader's Note(s): This can become personal. Create a safe space, but don't force people to share too deeply. If a group member takes over the conversation, thank them for their vulnerability and suggest having a side conversation after. Remember, you are a facilitator and not a counselor. If anyone shares a serious matter, please refer them to a pastor or professional counselor.

9. The Colossians struggled with blending Jesus with other beliefs. What are modern-day ways people do this? Where do you see this happening today?
 10. Do you ever feel like you need to perform or earn God's love and acceptance? Where do you think that belief comes from? What extra baggage might be weighing you down?
