Matthew 5:13-16

[13] “You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people’s feet.

[14] “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. [15] Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. [16] In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. (ESV)

Reflection Questions:

1. Where in your daily life have you been more prone to withdrawing from the world, or to blending into it? What might it look like to live in the tension Jesus calls you to?
2. Jesus says salt that loses its saltiness is 'no longer good for anything.' What habits, relationships, or compromises are quietly eroding your distinctiveness as a follower of Christ? What is one concrete step toward recovering that saltiness?
3. The sermon teaches that even our 'impurities' — past wounds, failures, and weaknesses — can be redeemed by God to connect us more deeply with others. Is there a part of your story you have been reluctant to share? How might God use it as a bridge to someone who needs Him?
