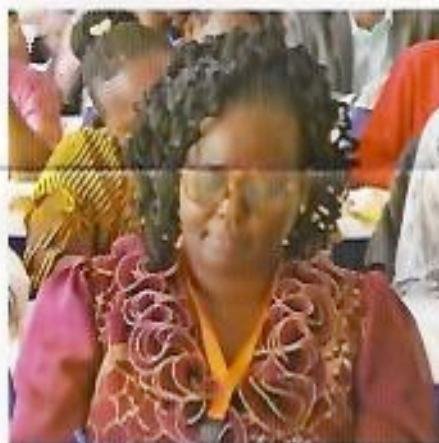


A MESSAGE FROM TASOS

ACROSS KENYA, in some of the most remote and impoverished regions, pastors are faithfully leading churches, but many are doing so without ever having had access to solid biblical training.

Sadly, this lack of training has left churches vulnerable. False teachings, prosperity gospel, and other distorted messages have quietly taken root, confusing believers and weakening the foundation of the Church.

Yet, among these challenges, something powerful is happening.

Through AMG's pastor training initiatives, made possible by faithful donors like you, lives and ministries are being transformed.

Last year, you helped bring training to regions where sound gospel teaching is desperately lacking. Pastors came hungry not just for knowledge, but for truth. Together, they studied foundational doctrines, focusing on the authority and sufficiency of God's Word.

And the impact was immediate:

"Understanding the sufficiency of God's Word has set me free from having to use gimmicks in my attempt to pass on the gospel. I have learned that God's Word is sufficient to bring one to the knowledge of God and to enable one to live a thriving Christian life." — Pastor Koech

"Knowing the authority of God's Word has changed my approach. In the past, I depended on dreams and visions, but now my focus is on God's written Word. I ought to hold God's Word with the highest regard; it is the final authority." — Pastor Simon
