Series Big Idea: We, the Church, remain as a continuation of the book of Acts. The work that Jesus finished on the cross he now continues through his Spirit-filled church.

This Week's Anchor Question:

How do we follow Jesus on mission when the path forward is unclear, unexpected, or costly?

When the path is unclear we trust the Spirit's leading...(1-10)

- With wisdom and discernment (1-5)
- Trusting the closed doors (6-8)
- Responding to God's Call (9-10)

When the path is unexpected we join God's work...(11-24)

- Open hearts (11-15)
- Spiritual Conflict (16-18)
- Costly Disruption (19-24)

When the path is costly we witness through faithfulness...(25-40)

- Worship in Suffering (25-26)
- Before a watching world (27-34)
- Living as a faithful witness (35-40)

Opening Prompt: *How does the mission of Jesus continue to multiply even as it encounters resistance, misunderstanding, and suffering?*

Read the text from 2 different versions – Acts 16

Looking Back – Understanding the Text

1. What surprised you or stood out differently hearing the text again?
2. What seems unfinished, unresolved, or still in motion in this passage?
3. What does this text reveal about how Jesus works through ordinary people?

Looking Inward – Formation & the Heart

4. Where do you resonate with the disciples or early church in this passage?
5. What fears, expectations, or distractions does this text gently expose?
6. How does this passage invite deeper trust in Jesus and dependence on the Spirit?

Looking Around – Community & Witness

7. How does this text shape the way we relate to one another as a church?
8. What would it look like to live this passage out together, not just individually?
9. Where might God be positioning us for witness—near or far?

Looking Forward – Participation in God's Ongoing Work

10. What step of obedience or attentiveness feels most pressing this week?
11. Where might Jesus be asking us to wait, pray, speak, or move?
12. Who in our lives might God be drawing toward Himself through us?

Would you consider helping us with our summer VBS outreach this year?

- 1. Volunteers to hang out with our kids:** No prep is needed; we just ask that you would be willing to spend a little time with our kids for 5 evenings from 6:00 - 8:30 PM, the week of June 22-26. They are looking for someone to direct them from one activity to another and offer help when they need it. Our site leaders will prepare the crafts, snack, Bible lesson, and games - you just encourage the kids to participate!
- 2. Prayer:** Over the next few weeks, you'll see "prayer tab" on the hallway bulletin board. These tabs list a person or group of people or kids. Some of these folks have been organizing and preparing for several months. Others are for the kids, the volunteers that have signed up to lead a group of kids, the folks who will prepare meals for our volunteers, and even the folks who will help to clean up and store the decorations & supplies for another year. Grab one and pray for us!
- 3. Volunteers:** Folks to help with building and painting sets, making decorations, and creating an atmosphere that is eye-catching for students.
- 4. More volunteers to help with tear down and clean up** on the last evening (June 26). Many hands make light work and our teachers are grateful for any help to remove things from walls, carrying materials to storage areas, disposing of trash, and helping to transport large items to their resting place for another year.
- 5. Meals for Volunteers:** We like to provide a "grab-n-go" meal for our VBS volunteers each evening before the chaos begins! This has turned out to be a real blessing to them. If you would be able to provide a light meal (or even dessert) on any night, please let me know. Favorites have been Walking Tacos (already claimed) and Pizza, to name a couple. Meal choice is up to you, and you can partner with someone to lighten the load. There are typically 35-40 present for these meals.
- 6. Craft & Snack Donations:** Information on ways you can contribute, purchase, or donate craft & snack supplies will be available on the hallway bulletin board in the next week, or scan the QR code to sign up & shop online.
