There are 7 things you need to know about Immersion English camp.

1. God is using this camp to change lives! Every year we've seen people come to Christ or draw closer to God. Seeing lives transformed is the most exciting thing in the world!
2. People get to improve their English skills. This is what draws most campers, a chance to speak English 24/7 with native speakers. Not only do they enjoy 2 hours of English lessons every day, they practice speaking and listening all day long.
3. Camp is a blessing to the volunteers. The opportunity to help others and develop friendships, while experiencing life in another culture is enriching. I love seeing volunteers return year after year.
4. In 2014 an English camp in Donetsk, Ukraine dissolved when their region was attacked and invaded by Russian troops. The American team was looking for a new location, and our friend, Leroy Frankin, suggested Poland. Meanwhile, we had seen the effectiveness of English camps in Poland. Our supporting churches were looking for opportunities to send teams to help us. It was certainly God using His people in His timetable.
5. More than one camper shared their delight at the friendliness of our staff. They claimed that the atmosphere of this camp was unlike any other, so positive and full of joy! They felt welcomed, included, and heard.
6. We are still involved. Even though we are now serving in Spain, we will continue to help with Immersion English Camp in Poland.
7. Immersion English Camp is non-profit. No one makes any money at this camp. We budget only for the expected expenses.
