Updates from Partners Cont.

“For Thursday of Holy Week, the Passover, we observed a traditional Seder meal. As we broke bread together, we were reminded of how every part of the meal pointed God’s covenant people towards Jesus Christ as the coming Messiah. Jesus is the ultimate Passover Lamb who was slain for our sins from the foundation of the world (Revelation 13:8). His body (bread) was broken for us, and His blood (wine) poured out for us. God’s wrath “passes over” those who are united to Him by grace through faith. Jesus thus instituted the Lord’s Supper on the Passover, which serves a similar purpose for us on this side of the cross.”
