1 Peter 5:14, *"Greet one another with a kiss of love."*

Hosea 13:2, *"Let the men who sacrifice kiss the calves!"*

Proverbs 27:6, *"Faithful are the wounds of a friend, but deceitful are the kisses of an enemy."*

Matthew 26:49, *"Immediately Judas went to Jesus and kissed Him."*
