Scripture – 1 Corinthians 14:40

“Let everything be done decently and in order.”

Devotional Reflection

God is not only concerned with what you believe—He is concerned with how you live. Scripture makes it clear that everything should be done in order, which means your life is not meant to feel scattered or directionless. Order is not about perfection; it is about alignment. When things are in order, your life begins to reflect clarity instead of confusion.

Many times, the reason life feels overwhelming is not because there is too much to do, but because there is no clear structure. When priorities are not defined, everything feels urgent. When there is no order, your time, energy, and focus begin to scatter. This is where frustration begins to build.

Order creates clarity. When your life is structured, you begin to see what matters most. You recognize what needs your attention and what needs to be adjusted. Clarity does not remove responsibility, but it gives you direction in how to manage it.

As your life comes into order, your thinking begins to settle. What once felt overwhelming becomes manageable. What once felt unclear becomes focused. This is how transformation begins to show up in your everyday life.

Today, take a moment to evaluate what feels out of order. You don't have to fix everything at once. Start by bringing one area into alignment. Small adjustments create meaningful clarity.
