

PRAYER PROMISES FOR NHC FINANCIAL BLESSINGS:

(One PRAYER PROMISE per DAY for the MONTH of MAY)

1. **Leviticus 27:30:** “A tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the LORD; it is holy to the LORD.
2. **Deut. 8:18:** But remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today.
3. **Deut. 15:10:** Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the LORD your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to.
4. **Deut. 16:17:** Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the LORD your God has blessed you.
5. **1Samuel 2:7:** The LORD sends poverty and wealth; he humbles and he exalts.
6. **Psalms 24:1:** The earth is the LORD’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it.
7. **Proverbs 3:9-10:** Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.
8. **Proverbs 10:22:** The blessing of the LORD brings wealth, without painful toil for it.
9. **Proverbs 11:24:** One person gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty.
10. **Proverbs 14:23:** All hard work brings a profit, but mere talk leads only to poverty.
11. **Proverbs 22:4:** Humility is the fear of the LORD; its wages are riches and honor and life.
12. **Jeremiah 29:11:** For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.
13. **Malachi 3:10:** Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.
14. **Matthew 6:25-26:** Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?
15. **Matthew 6:31-33:** So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
16. **Matthew 7:11:** If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!
17. **Matthew 17:20:** If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”

18. **Mark 12:43-44:** Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, “Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on.”
19. **Luke 6:38:** Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
20. **Luke 11:9-10:** “So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.
21. **John 15:7:** If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.
22. **Romans 12:13:** Share with the Lord’s people who are in need. Practice hospitality.
23. **2Corinthians 8:9:** For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich.
24. **2Corinthians 8:12-13:** For if the willingness is there, the gift is acceptable according to what one has, not according to what one does not have. Our desire is not that others might be relieved while you are hard pressed, but that there might be equality.
25. **2Corinthians 9:6-8:** Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.
26. **2Corinthians 9:10-11:** Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.
27. **Galatians 6:9:** Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
28. **Ephesians 3:20:** Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
29. **Philippians 4:18-19:** I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.
30. **Hebrews 11:6:** And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
31. **Hebrews 13:16:** And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.
