**Primary Text(s): Colossians 1:21-29**

Read

- *Colossians 1:21-29.*

Drift Awareness

- Paul warns believers not to drift (Colossians 1:23). *Why is drifting still possible even for those who follow Jesus, and what are some early signs that it may be happening?*
- *Where do you sense you might be drifting right now, even subtly or gradually?*

Pressure 1: The Strain of Suffering

- *How can suffering or disappointment begin to affect our trust in God?*
- *When life becomes difficult, do you tend to move toward Jesus or create distance? What usually shapes that response?*
- Paul viewed suffering as participation in Christ’s life. *How does that perspective challenge or reshape the way you see your own struggles?*

Pressure 2: The Responsibilities We Resist

- *What is one area of responsibility, personal or spiritual, that you sense God has entrusted to you, but you may be hesitating to step into?*
- *Why do you think hesitation or fear in responding to God’s calling can lead to spiritual drift?*

Gospel Hope + Response

- “Christ in you, the hope of glory” is our anchor. *What would it look like, practically, for you to lean into that reality this week?*
